

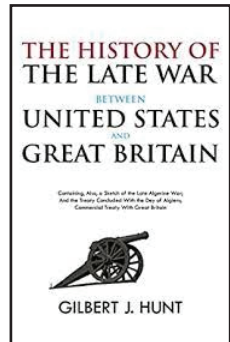

- A. "And it came to pass on the forth day of the seventh month, which is the birth day of Columbian Liberty and Independence." p.139
- B. "About this time a stripling from the south, with his weapon of war in his hand...the young man entreated him (Jackson) a second time saying, I beseech thee, let me step out before the host and slay him." p.103
"Immediately Jackson took 2000 hardy men, who were called volunteers, because they faught freely for their country...and [were] men of dauntless courage." p.183
- C. "Yea, it was dreadful as the mighty earthquake, which overturneth cities. And the whole face of the Earth round-about...were overshadowed with black smoke; so that, for a time, one man saw not another." p.104
- D. "...send forth a Proclamation...he invited the people...to join themselves to the hosts of Columbia, who were come to drive the servants of the Kin from their borders. And it came to pass, that a great multitude flocked to the banners..." p.38
- E. "Now these...were made partly of brass and partly of iron, and were...contrived with curious works, like unto a clock; and as it were a large ball." p.279
- F. "His name was Christopher, sur-named Columbus...it came to pass...that he crossed the waters of the mighty deep, a thing that had never been known among the sons of men." p.108
- G. "Manahoe, their chief prophet, was smitten in the mouth, and slain." p.187
- H. "...even then shall not the sacred cause of liberty perish, ..." p.131
- I. "...they couched down as a lion, and as a young lion, they watched for theri prey." p.90
- J. "...inhabitants...whose hearts yearned after the King of Britian...the blind Followers of Royalty." p.25
- K. "Nevertheless, it was so that the freemen who came to the defense of the city..." p. 275
