Note: all of these appear in the BofM in the same order as the original document order:

- A. "...the state of Men after death, and of the resurrection."
- B. "...their souls...return to God who gave them."
- C. "The souls of the righteous...are received into the highest heavens..."
- D. "...the souls of the wicked are cast into hell, ...and utter darkness."
- E. "...the souls of the wicked... remain in...darkness, reserved to the judgment of the great day."
- F. "...bodies...shall be united again to thier souls."

Chapter 33

These references are not in order, and although familiar do not appear in the KJV Bible in this manner, but they do appear in the Westminister Confessions with matching phrases.

- G. "God from all eternity."
- H. "infinite goodness of God."
- I. "...our first parents."
- J. "...before the tribunal of Christ."
- K. "...thoughts, words, and deeds."
- L. "...carnal security."
